

Build a Fuel-Efficient Stove

Many Guatemala village women suffer from respiratory and eye problems due to cooking over an open fire on their kitchen floor. For a gift of \$35, a safe and healthier cooking stove can be built. This stove is fuel-efficient, elevated, and the smoke from the burning wood is vented outside, there by improving the quality of the air inside the home. The family brings some of the materials, which encourages ownership and participation.





Train Rural Pastors

Help equip rural pastors in Guatemala as they study God's Word and learn how to shepherd their local congregations. Your donation will make it possible for trained teachers to travel to isolated areas where they provide monthly Bible and theology classes in their native Mayan languages.





Build a Clinic/Hospital

Poverty and inequality of both income and access to healthcare are among the structural problems Guatemala faces. A gift of \$100 will buy block and mortar for the clinic/hospital building project on the outskirts of Sumpango.

Family Health Checkup

An entire rural family can receive a basic medical examination and laboratory tests for \$40. These medical visits help detect health conditions that, if left untreated, could become very serious. Our desire is to provide quality medical care to rural families in need.



Growing Healthy Young Girls

A daily glass of protein-rich soymilk and a supplemental vitamin are two ways Próximos Pasos School is able to impact the normal physiological development of their students. This higher level of nutrition greatly improves the girls' ability to learn and comprehend their classroom subjects. Your gift will enable us to continue to provide soymilk and vitamins for our students.



Weaving Class Supplies

A gift of \$40 will assist in the purchase of colorful threads and other necessary supplies for weaving classes for women from rural villages in the Ixcán area of Guatemala. These weaving classes include Bible study and prayer time, an encouragement for the women in their spiritual growth.



Youth Discipleship Material

Guatemala's youth are hungry for the Word of God! Throughout Mission Impact ministries there is a need for discipleship materials and Bibles. These resources help young people come to know Christ and grow in their relationship with Him and obedience to His Word.
