I'm happy to be able to write to you with updates about my work and ministry here in Guatemala. 2015 has been a very busy year for me teaching at the University as well as my role as principal at Vida y Esperanza.

University

Three days a week you can find me at the University in Guatemala City. I teach two morning classes during the week and a Saturday class. My classes during the week are geared for students from 18 to 20 years old who are studying to be teachers. Guatemala now requires teachers to have additional education before they can teach in the classroom. My Saturday class is geared towards teachers in their 30's and 40's, who are studying to be principals in the school system. What I love about teaching at the University is that I begin each class with a group discussion on topics of leadership and ethics. I'll use books from Christian leaders like Max Lucado and Rick Warren. These group discussions provide a forum for me to be able to share the Gospel with my students in the University setting.

I can not believe another school year is coming to an end. We had a successful Parent's Night in August where the worship team performed for the parents and grades were distributed.

We have had many successes during the school year, but a few challenges as well. A few of our students have been struggling with addictions and strongholds in their lives. The blessing is that they have been coming to me for help and counseling.
